

Photography Tip Sheet PERSPECTIVE

- **High Angle Shot:** position the camera above the subject

POWER of this Technique:

- Subject may look thinner
- Emphasis the smallness of a subject
- Subject may look shorter or more youthful



- **Low Angle Shot:** shoot upward on a subject by crouching or while laying down

POWER of this Technique:

- Subject may appear physically larger
- Subject may appear out of proportion
- Can make heroes look more heroic and obstacles look more menacing



- **Straight on Shot:** position the camera eye level with the subject

POWER of this Technique:

- Subjects appear in their true form
- Does not alter subject's proportions
